JAY – Conrad S. Hutchinson, 83, of Jay, beloved husband, father, grandfather and friend passed away Wednesday August 8, 2018 at his home with his loving family by his side. It was especially wonderful that he taught his son Jerry to grow up to do the same thing- put caring for family first. It wasn't long before

Conrad would have worked a full day, have his own chores and obligations at home, but he would not hesitate to come help out his mother or aunt at a moments notice. May you take comfort in the strength of your family and the many wonderful things your dad taught all of you, Jeff and Jerry.
